QUALITY NEIGHBORHOODS

Residents and visitors to Winona should enjoy the quality of their homes and neighborhoods. The City has established ordinances to help maintain and improve neighborhoods for the enjoyment of all.

- Accumulation of unlicensed vehicles, parts, tires, construction material, old appliances, and furniture, to name a few, in a yard is in violation of City Code.
- Cover garbage containers and empty every seven days.
- Mow lawns before reaching 6" in height.
- Shovel sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall ends.
- Park vehicles in driveways, garages, or on the street. Vehicles may not be parked on front or side yards. Observe the 20 hour street parking limit.
- Park on the odd and even sides of the street on odd and even dates after midnight from November 1 to April 1.

UTILITIES

Public Works manages utilities including water, wastewater, streets, and park maintenance.

Paying utility bills is convenient with online payment option at www.cityofwinona-mn.com designed for residents' convenience and to save on mailing costs.

A compost site is available for residents to use for yard waste and prunings. The site is located at 1815 Shives Road and is open from 12 to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday.

The Police Department provides traditional police services. They also enforce parking and animal control.
