BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES: Home Care services are provided for persons of all ages. Registered nurses are available to assess health status, monitor vital signs, assist with medications and dressing changes, and provide teaching as needed. Nurses communicate closely with physician to develop an individualized plan of care. Home health aides are available to assist with personal care, range of motion exercises, meal preparation, and incidental homemaking. Physical, occupational, speech, and respiratory therapies are provided as needed.

Agency is licensed by the Minnesota Department of Health and certified by Medicare.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Based on need

HOURS: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday
Weekend aide service is available

FEES: No charge for initial assessment visit. Funding sources include: Medicare, Medical Assistance, private insurance, VA, full fee and sliding fee scales.

COMMENTS: Health Maintenance clinics are available at Winhaven Court, Valley View Towers, Kensington Apts., Cathedral Church Apostolate and St. Stanislaus Harvest House group. Blood pressure clinics regularly scheduled throughout the county. Annual flu clinics in the fall; price determined by cost of vaccine. Adult screening clinics are held monthly at the Winona Senior Friendship Center for a small fee.
