**SUBJECT: PUBLIC ACTIVITIES**

---

**1.0 PURPOSE:**

It is the purpose of this general order to clearly define the rules and regulations pertaining to public activities affecting all members of the Winona Police Department.

**2.0 POLITICAL RIGHTS:**

The right of every member of the department to entertain political or partisan opinion, or the right of the elective franchise, will be deemed sacred and inviolate. Any member's further involvement in the political system shall be in accordance with State or Federal law.

**3.0 SUBVERSIVE ORGANIZATIONS:**

No member shall knowingly become a member of or connected with any subversive organization, except when necessary in the performance of duty and then only under the direction of the Chief of Police. "Subversive organization" means any organization on the Attorney General of the United States' Subversive list.

**4.0 PERSONAL PREFERMENT:**

No member of this department may seek the influence of, or intervention of any person outside the department for purposes of personal preferment, advantage, transfer or advancement.

**5.0 OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT:**

Prior to engaging in any outside business, or employment, the member shall submit a request for permission to do so to the Chief of Police through official channels.
