SUBJECT: PATROL ZONES

1.0 PURPOSE:

It is the intent of this general order to clearly define the boundary lines for each Patrol Zone utilized by the Patrol Bureau.

2.0 POLICY:

2.1 This policy shall not restrict the on-duty Supervisor from making temporary adjustments and/or assignments based on need.

2.2 The Shift Supervisor has the discretion to utilize either the two- or three-zone deployment plan.

3.0 PROCEDURE:

3.1 Two Zones - East and West:

3.1.1 The dividing line shall be Center Street.

3.1.2 Wincrest and Garvin Heights areas shall be the responsibility of the East Zone.

3.1.3 Latsch Island and Dick's Marine areas shall be the responsibility of the West Zone.

3.2 Three Zones - East, Central, and West:

3.2.1 East Zone: Franklin Street east.

3.2.2 Central Zone: Franklin Street on the east and Huff Street on the west.

3.2.3 West Zone: Huff Street west.

3.2.4 The Central Zone will have responsibility for Dick's Marine, Latsch Island, Wincrest, and Garvin Heights.

3.2.5 Overlap Zone - for East and West Zones only, to permit extra coverage of Lake Park and downtown areas. They can patrol into the Central Zone as necessary.

3.3 Any unit leaving its assigned sector outside of overlap areas shall advise Dispatch.
