



Bob Welch Aquatic Center Rules & Reminders

Below is a list of the posted rules at the Bob Welch Aquatic Center. The list is not all inclusive, but a guide to the behavior and expectations that are in place for those who choose to attend the Aquatic Center.

Bob Welch Aquatic Center Rules:

1. Children 7 and under must be accompanied by a responsible care provider.
2. Children 4 and under must be within arm's reach of a responsible care provider at all times.
3. We strongly recommend any person who has been potty trained for less than one year use plastic pants.
4. Please shower before entering the pool.
5. Only US Coast Guard approved flotation devices may be used; any person using a flotation must be within arm's reach of a responsible care provider at all times.
6. Diving is only allowed off diving boards; no inverse, inward, back dives or gainers allowed.
7. Foul or abusive language or clothing, public displays of affection, and or inappropriate behavior are not allowed and are at the discretion of staff.
8. Pushing, dunking, splashing, rough play fighting, and any activity that endangers the safety and comfort of self or others are prohibited.
9. Secure personal belongings; the City of Winona is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
10. Prior to swimming in the deep end (use of diving board), guests must pass a swim test. A swim test may be requested more than once per visit or season.
11. Please enjoy food or beverages in designated areas; no glass, alcohol or tobacco allowed on property.
12. Lap swimmers 16 years or older may continue to swim laps during safety breaks.

Additional rules will be enforced at the discretion of Aquatic Center staff.
