POSITION SUMMARY

Under immediate supervision, this maintenance position performs wastewater equipment and sanitary sewer maintenance work including the use of heavy equipment combined with technical knowledge in a specialized area. This position may be required to serve as night watchman.

JOB DUTIES OR ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The essential functions of the position include, but are not limited to the following:

- Cleans and inspect wastewater plant and equipment and repair equipment and pumps using various hand and power tools.
- Repairs and maintains all mechanical equipment used for the operation and maintenance of the wastewater plant and sewerage system on a regular basis.
- Cleans, paints, and makes other repairs of the physical properties, buildings and wastewater plants.
- Shovels and plows snow to maintain access to plant controls.
- Inspects and records data from mechanical and electrical equipment.
- Collects and tests water and sewage samples, using testing equipment.
- Hauls sludge and maintain sludge spreading records.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this position successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the formal education, experience and training required.

Education

High school diploma or GED certificate required

Experience

One (1) year of wastewater technology, mechanics, plumbing, or related experience

Trainings, Certificates, and Licenses

- Possess a valid Class B Commercial Driver's License with Tanker Endorsement
- Possess a valid Class D Wastewater Operators License

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

The requirements listed below are representative of the formal education, experience and training preferred in order to exceptionally perform all of the functions of this position.

Education

Associate's Degree or equivalent training at a technical or vocational school with a focus on wastewater technology, mechanics, plumbing, or related field

Experience

Three (3) years of wastewater technology, mechanics, plumbing, or related experience

COMPLEXITY

The overall complexity of this position is moderately low. While performing the normal duties of this job, there are related steps, processes, and methods that require this position to recognize clear differences in a variety of situations.

RESPONSIBILITY

Supervision

Immediate supervision is provided while performing the normal duties of this job.

This position exhibits no supervisory responsibilities.

Impact

While performing the normal duties of this job, this positions work product or services affect the accuracy, reliability, or acceptability of further processes or services.

REQUIRED PHYSICAL ABILITIES AND WORK CONDITIONS

Hazards

While performing the duties of this job, this position:

- May occasionally balance, crawl, sit, run, push/pull 50 to 100 lbs., lift 50 to 100 lbs., carry 50 to 100 lbs., finger/enter data/keystroke, and feel; frequently climb 150 to 500 steps, bend/stoop, kneel, crouch, squat, reach above shoulder level, and drive; and continuously stand, talk, hear, smell, and perform repetitive motions.
- Will use close vision, far vision, depth perception, visual accommodation, color vision, and peripheral vision.
- Will use their right hand and left hand for simple handling or grasping, and fine handling or manipulation.
- Will use their right foot and left foot for repetitive motions.

Surroundings

While performing the duties of this job, this position will experience exposure to inside environmental conditions, exposure to outside environmental conditions, exposure to noise, dust, fumes, gases, chemicals, or oils requiring special mitigating precautions or protective gear, working in narrow aisles or passageways, work around moving mechanical parts, working in close quarters, exposure to extreme heat, exposure to extreme cold, and exposure to infectious diseases.
