All you need to do is come to the Youth Services Desk or go to our website starting June 6th and sign up. You will receive a reading log and sheet of stickers to track your minutes. 1 sticker = 10 minutes of completed reading time. For every 100 minutes of completed reading, bring your reading log to the Youth Services Desk to earn a prize. There are 5 prize levels total. It's easy: read what you want, where you want, when you want. Read a book, magazine or screen, be read to by an adult, listen to audiobooks—it all counts! **Prizes can be claimed from June 20 through July 30th.** Check out our variety of programming spread over 7 weeks this summer. 
