Quality Neighborhoods

Residents enjoy the quality of their homes and neighborhoods. Ordinances have been established to help maintain and improve neighborhoods for the enjoyment of all.

- ✦ Accumulation of unlicensed vehicles, parts, tires, construction material, old appliances, and furniture, to name a few, in a yard is in violation of City Code.
- ✦ Cover garbage containers and empty every seven days.
- ✦ Mow lawns before reaching 6" in height.
- ✦ Shovel sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall ends.
- ✦ Park vehicles in driveways, garages, or on the street. Vehicles may not be parked on front or side yards. Observe the 20 hour street parking limit.
- ✦ Park on the odd and even sides of the street on odd and even dates after midnight from November 15 to March 15.
